

## **Governor Signs Legislation to Raise Minimum Wage**

“Joined by members of the General Assembly, Gov. Jack Markell signed into law Senate Bill 6, Jan. 30 which will raise the minimum wage in Delaware to \$8.25 per hour in two increments. Under legislation that cleared both the Senate and House recently, the state’s hourly minimum wage will go up 50 cents to \$7.75 on June 1, 2014. On June 1, 2015, it will go up another 50 cents to \$8.25 per hour, making it \$1 higher than the current federal minimum wage”.

“There was no increase in the server tip wage which remains at \$2.23 per hour”.
